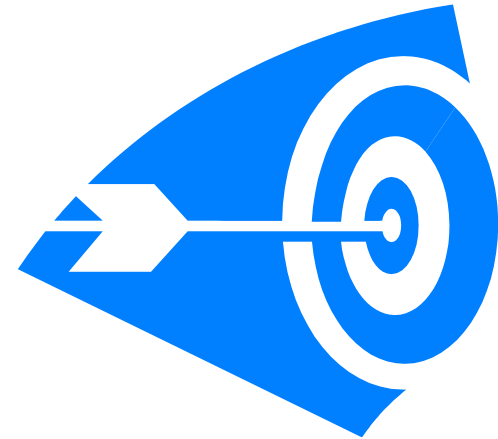

Aim

- ◆ This presentation gives a technique to improve fluency in the language;
be it English, Telugu, or some other





What is JAM?

- ◆ JAM stands for Just A Minute
i.e., Speak for Just A Minute
- ◆ JAM helps Building Confidence to speak in a given situation
- ◆ Best played as a Game of fun and learn



Pre-requisites

- ◆ A minimum of 2 participants
- ◆ A Judge/Moderator
- ◆ At least 10 topics
e.g., Grass, culture, stars, bottles, etc.
- ◆ A Watch, preferably a Stop Watch
- ◆ Microphone, if necessary





Rules of the Game

- ◆ Sit around a table
- ◆ Select the first speaker (Random, Draw, or by Judge)
- ◆ Moderator gives a topic to the speaker
- ◆ The speaker starts talking on moderator's signal
- ◆ Scoring is based on the duration of the speech; the longer you speak, more you would get.

Rules of the Game continued...

- ◆ Other participants object and take the chance to speak, if correct.
Explained separately.
- ◆ When the minute is over on the topic, the scoring is concluded for the round.
- ◆ Play as many rounds as the team wishes to play.
- ◆ The one that has the maximum score is the winner.



Skill Focus

- ◆ No Unclear words or flow of speech
- ◆ No Stuttering & Stammering
- ◆ No Late Start for more than 3 seconds
- ◆ No Pause for more than 3 seconds
- ◆ No Repetition of words except the Topic
- ◆ Not more than two continuous sentences
Unrelated to the Topic

“Objections”



Scoring

- ◆ Number of seconds of speech
- ◆ Bonus if speaks till the end of the minute
- ◆ Objection
 - ◆ First person raising the hand & saying the word “Objection”
 - ◆ When valid: Gets the turn to speak
 - ◆ When invalid: Negative score to the person raising objection; previous speaker continues
- ◆ Winner: Highest scorer after the last round
